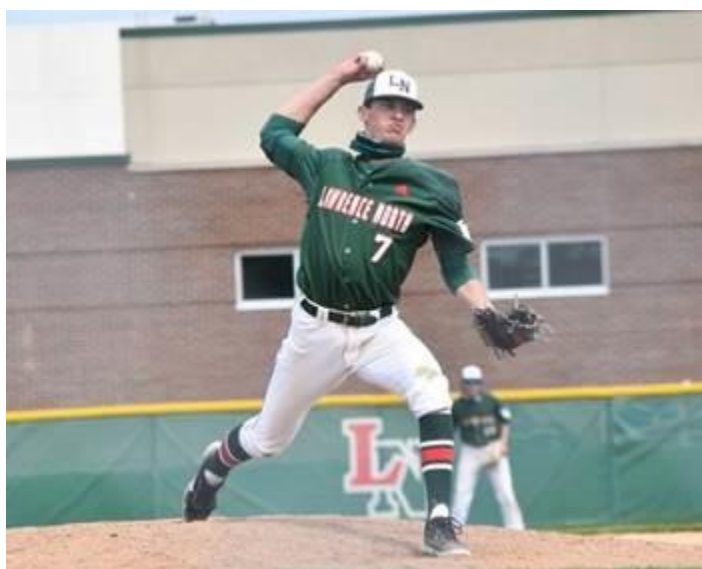

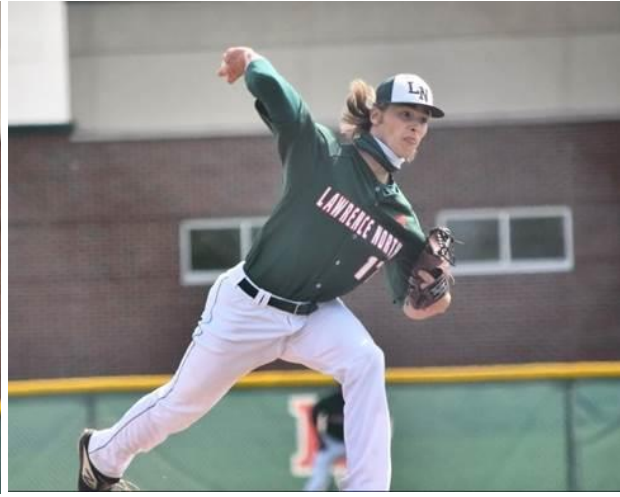
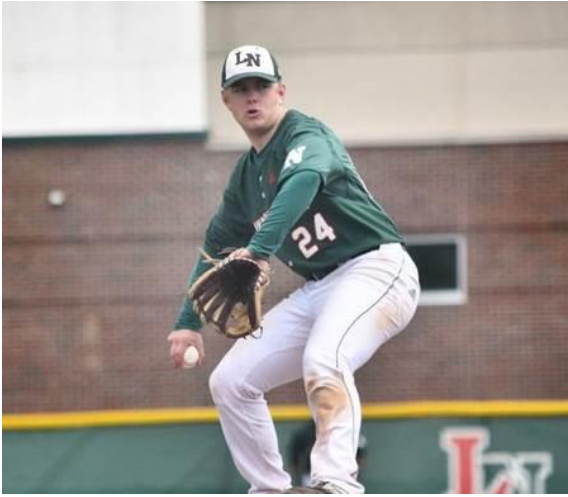
### **Lexi Satz (Tennis) and Owen Quinn (Baseball)**

The varsity 4 x 800m relay girls showed out at the Flashes Showcase on Friday night by improving their time by 15 seconds to 10:13.31! Way to go Brielle Vail, Carol Ludington, Olivia Back and Sam Springer! Ludington (5:38) & Vail (5:27) also represented the Wildcats well in the mile at the showcase. The Lady Wildcats competed again on Saturday at the HSE Royal Relays, and had a few standout performances by Sam Springer & Page DeFord in the 3200, Joi Henson in the 100. The 4x100 team of Khamari Dabney, Megan Barnum, Tionna Thompson and Henson placed 5<sup>th</sup> place overall. The team will compete at home on Tuesday against Pike/North Central and then again on Thursday with the Ben Davis/Center Grove JV meet.



### **Boys Track & Field:**

The boys team lost to Mt. Vernon on Tuesday, 79-53. On Friday, the team was split, competing at the Lafayette Jeff Sprint Invite and FC Flashes Distance Showcase. The team had many PR's last week. Jaden Freeney threw 50' in the shot put on Tuesday at MV then 53' on Friday at the North Montgomery relays. Dalys Jett and Rex Cade both High Jumped 5'10" to take first and second at MV. Freshman Izzy Jackson ran 11.3 in the 100 at MV to take first place, and then another first place in the 200, clocking 23.30. On Friday, Junior Kendall Moore-Harrison ran a season best 23.50 in the 200. Our Distance team of Winslow, Ivory, Ostendorf, and Rostron won nearly every event on Tuesday at Mt. Vernon and placed 4<sup>th</sup> in the 4x800 meter relay on Friday at the Distance showcase at Franklin Central.
