The Cardiac Cats did it again! Lawrence North (5-1, 4-1 MIC) defeated Warren Central in dramatic fashion, 24-21. Down 21-6 at halftime, The Wildcat defense shut out the Warriors in the second half, allowing the offense to come back. Ali Richardson ran 25 times for 128 yards and a touchdown. Montez Jones ran for 74 yards and a touchdown. He also threw for 167 yards and a touchdown. Omar Cooper caught four balls for 143 yards and a big touchdown in the fourth quarter to tie the game. Matthew Dempsey put the nail in the coffin by drilling a 28-yard field goal as time expired to win it for the Cats, 24-21. The defense come through BIG TIME in the second half. This unit has been solid all year! 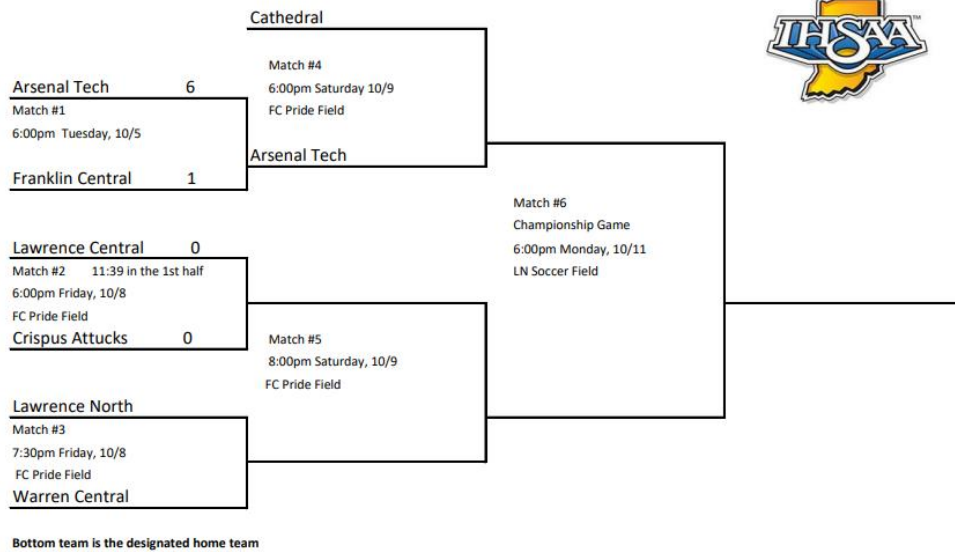
## Cross Country:

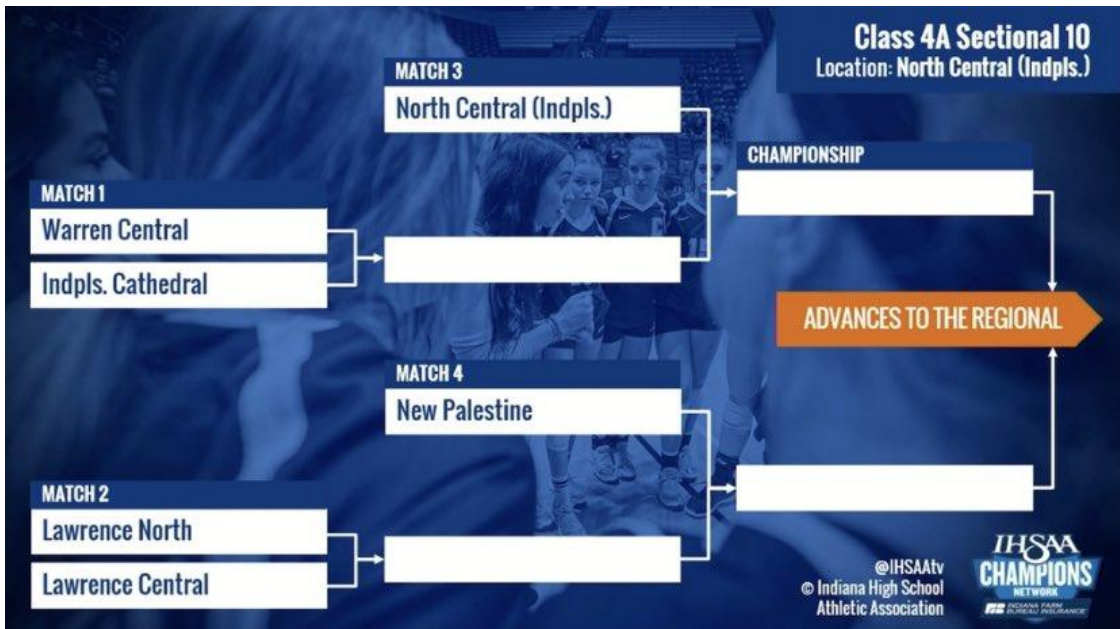
## Boys Tennis:
